What it involves

Members of the Board of Directors will be required to:

- Attend, participate in and prepare for quarterly meetings of the Board - each meeting lasts approximately three hours. Face to face meetings take place in London
- Actively contribute to the effective running of the Solar Energy UK
- Be willing to volunteer to support any ad hoc projects or participate in Sub-Committee work
- Uphold the interests and values of the Solar Energy UK membership

Please note the roles are unpaid and we are unfortunately unable to cover travel expenses. The Director post is held for three years, after which re-election is required.

Voting process

All individuals who put themselves forward will have their profile circulated to all Solar Energy UK members as from Friday 26th January 2024 until Monday 19th February 2024. The Board may also recommend candidates at this time.

During this period, members will be able to cast votes online in advance of the AGM taking place on 29th February 2024. The five candidates with the highest votes will be elected to the Board for a three year period and announced at the AGM.
